Type of tour	Airplane flight, guided bus tour
What's the tour about?	The history of the Grand Canyon is not just seen in the formation of the land, but in its inhabitants and their culture. Taking off on the “Indian Adventure” aboard a Vistaliner airplane will give you the Canyon’s celebrated scenery – Lake Mead, the Hoover Dam, and the West Rim – and then drop you in the middle of the Hualapai Nation. Upon arrival at the terminal the area shuttle service takes you to the Indian Village, which consists of five small exhibits depicting not only the Hualapai Tribe, but three other Arizona tribes and their authentic hand-constructed dwellings that are representative of many Plains Indians.

How long is the tour?	Approximately 7 hours from hotel pick-up to hotel drop-off, Approximately 30 minute flight from Boulder Terminal to Grand Canyon West.
